Eighth grade will be electing a School President along with 5 eighth grade representatives. Seventh grade will be electing a School Secretary and 5 seventh grade representatives. Sixth grade will be electing 5 sixth grade representatives. The candidate on each grade level that receives the highest number of votes for class representative will become that grade level's vice-president.

In order to run, a candidate must have had an A or B average in all core classes last year along with two positive teacher references. Candidates will also have to tape a one to two minute speech that will be videoed and then shown on election day which will be on Wed., Sept. 21st. If elected, members must be able to meet one afternoon per month from 3:30 – 5:00 and also some mornings at 7:30. Please consider this wonderful leadership opportunity.

- Members must be RESPECTFUL and RESPONSIBLE.*
- Members must give a 1-2 speech that will be videoed to show on election day.*
